

MovieOn Instruction Manual

1. Introduction

MovieOn is an app that directly plays media files stored on your device's storage (internal storage and SD card). You can enjoy content offline without an internet connection, while maintaining your privacy.

2. Browse and manage files

The following operations are possible in the "File Manager" on the main screen:

- Storage relocation: You can freely move folder hierarchies by switching between internal storage and SD cards.
- Filtering: You can switch between "Videos only," "Music only," "Images only," and "All" using the icons at the top of the screen.
- Sort: You can sort files in ascending or descending order by "Name" or "Date Modified".
- Switching display modes: You can switch between list view and grid view to change to your preferred layout.
- Multiple Selection: Press and hold a file to enter selection mode, allowing you to add or remove multiple files from a playlist at once.

3. Playback of videos and music

Tapping a media file will launch the player.

Basic operations

- Play/Pause: Operate using the button in the center of the screen or by tapping the screen.
- Seek (fast forward/rewind): Slide the progress bar or use the left and right skip buttons.
- Resume function: Automatically resumes playback from where you last left off.

Advanced player features (during video playback)

- Gesture control:
 - Swipe up or down on the left side of the screen: Adjust **brightness**
 - Swipe up or down on the right side of the screen: Adjust volume
- Track Selection: If a video includes subtitles or has multiple audio tracks, you can switch between them from the playback screen.
- Playback speed: You can play at your preferred speed, from 0.25x to 2.0x.
- Repeat/Shuffle: You can choose to repeat one song, repeat all songs, or shuffle playback.
- Aspect Ratio: You can switch the display to fit the screen size, such as "Fit," "Zoom," and "Full Screen."

4. Creating and editing playlists

You can manage your favorite files all in one place.

- To create: After selecting a file, choose "Add to playlist" and then select either a new playlist or an existing one.
- Editing: You can rearrange items in the playlist and delete specific items.
- Automatic synchronization: While playing a video in the playlist, it will automatically transition to the next file.

5. Image Viewer

Tapping an image file will open a feature-rich image viewer.

- You can swipe left or right to move between images.
- You can zoom in and out of the image using pinch gestures.

6. Settings and Customization

You can customize the app to your liking from the settings icon (gear) in the upper right corner.

- Change the theme: Choose from a variety of color themes, including "Sunset Coast," "Emerald Reef," and "Midnight Sky."
- Multilingual support: You can switch between many languages, including Japanese and English.
- Sleep timer: Automatically stops playback after a specified time (15 to 120 minutes). Convenient for use while sleeping.
- Hardware Decoding: If playback is not smooth, you can optimize it by toggling hardware decoding ON/OFF.

- **Watermark:** You can control the display of watermarks on the playback screen through the settings.

7. Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- **Files not showing:** Check if the app has "storage access permission". Also, unsupported file formats (such as special codecs) may not be displayed.
- **Files not found on the SD card:** From the top (root) of the file manager, select external storage.
- **Background playback:** For music files, you can continue playback and control playback from the notification bar even after closing the app.
